Health & Safety Terms

Thank you for your participation in the 2021 Orthopaedic Summit!

As a quick reminder and to ensure the health and safety of all our attendees, we'd like to highlight the safety terms and conditions agreed upon during your registration submission.

Orthopaedic Summit is requiring all registrants, faculty, administration, exhibitors, Bellagio staff, spouses, partners, and significant others to be fully COVID vaccinated to attend OSET. There are no exceptions.

Are you fully vaccinated against COVID-19? A person is considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 if they have completed the two-dose regimen of Moderna, Pfizer, or AstraZeneca vaccines or a single dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine administered at least two weeks before the commencement of the event.

Proof of COVID Vaccination is required. If you have not yet uploaded your vaccine card, please return to your registration account to submit.

Valid proof of COVID-19 vaccination must include a digital copy of vaccination card with full name, vaccine received, and dates of doses.

In addition, all attendees must present a negative PCR COVID test result within 72 hours of the first day of the meeting. Proof of a negative COVID PCR Test must be received prior to your arrival in Las Vegas. A digital copy of the negative test result must include the participant's full name and date the test was administered.

Last, all attendees will be required to complete a daily health survey and temperature checks will be required to enter the conference space. A separate link will be sent to you prior to the conference to provide this information.
